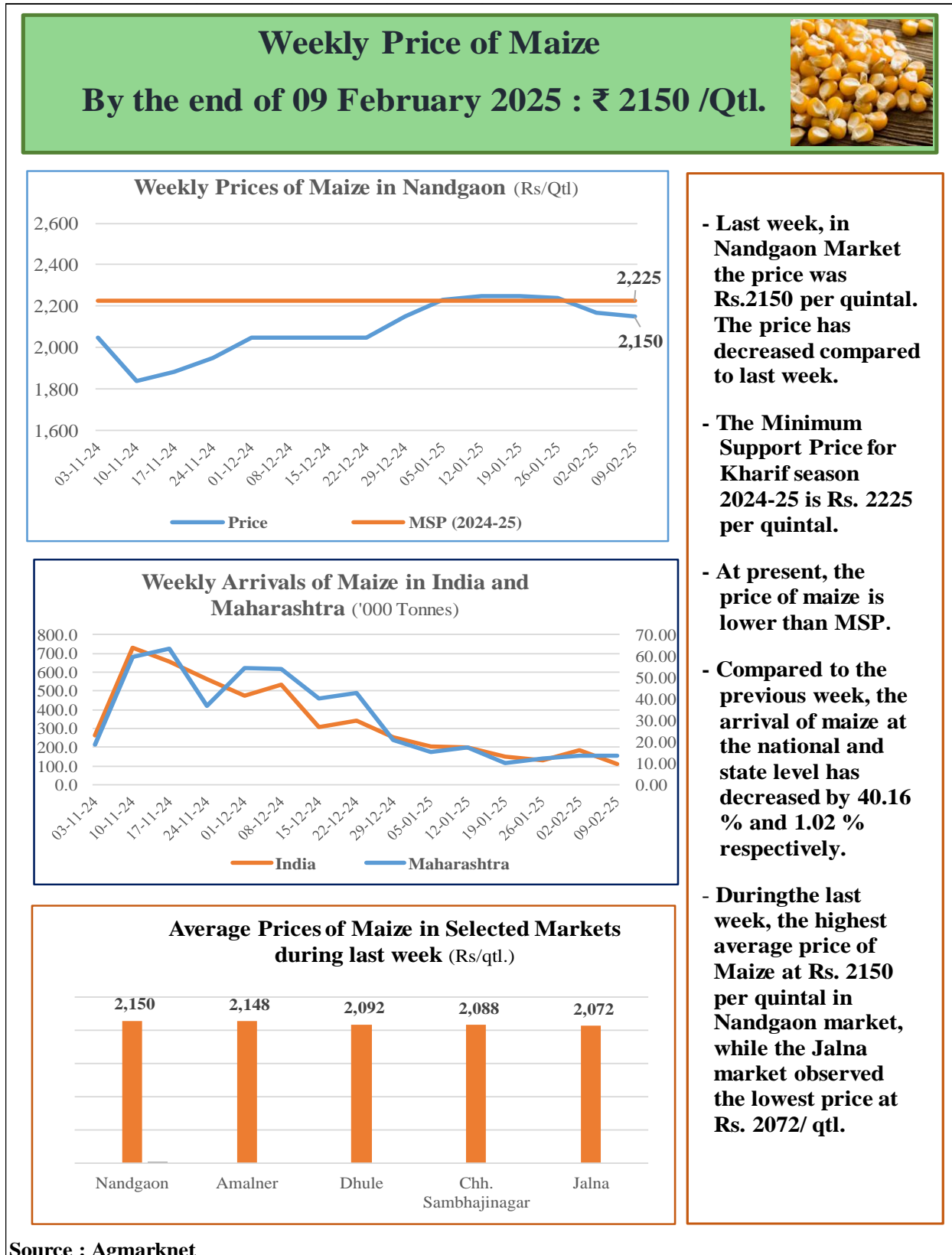

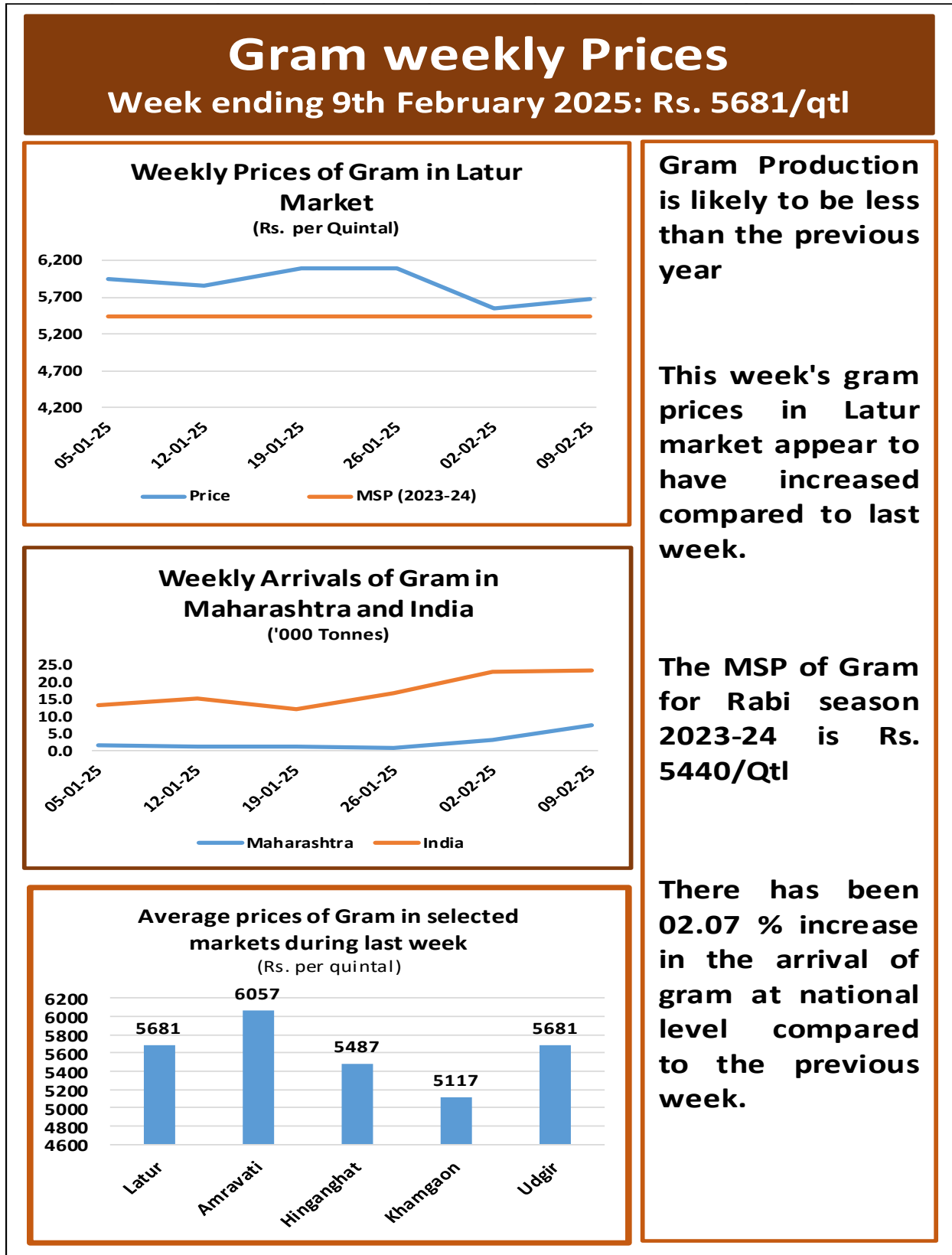

Tur Production is likely to be same as last year.

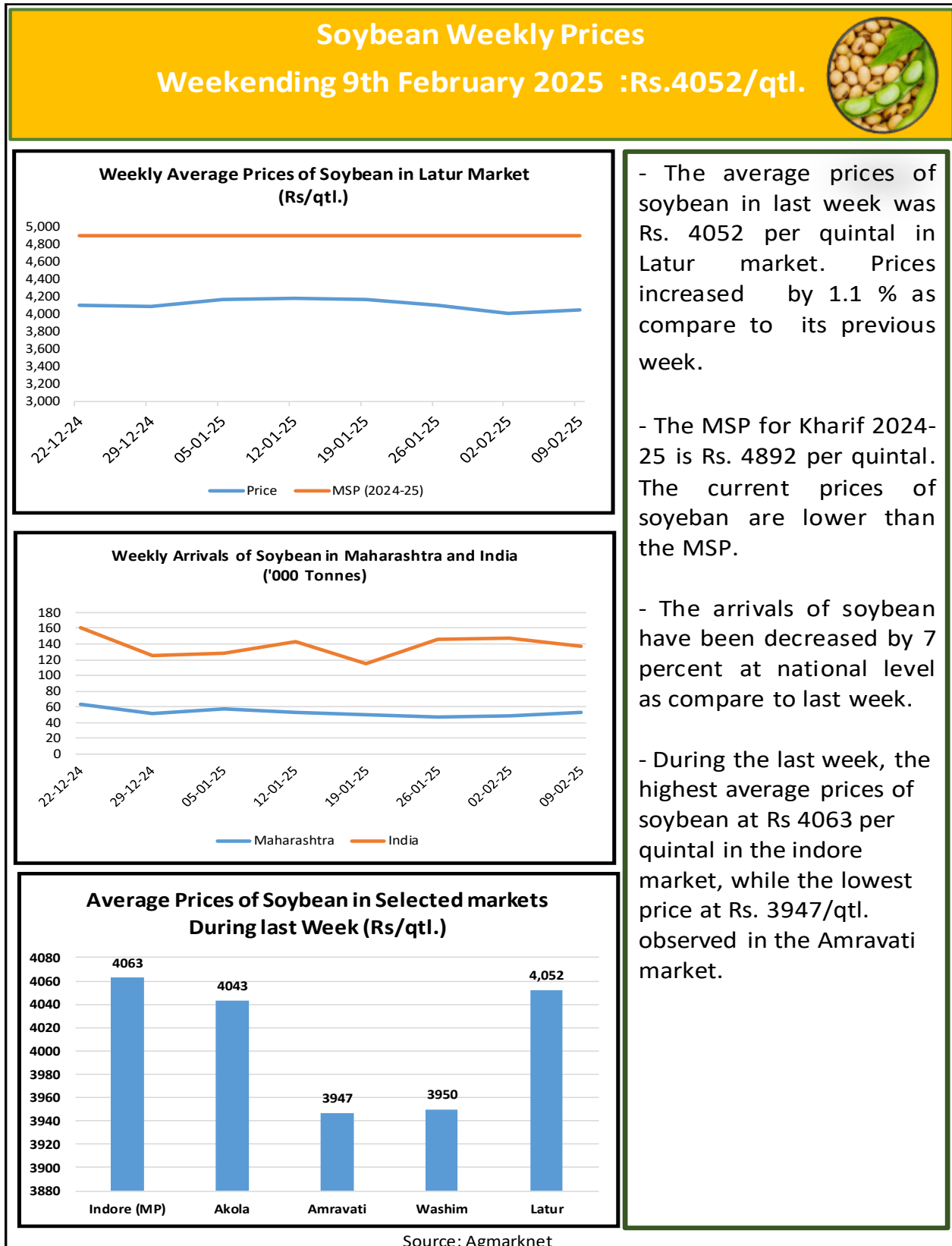
This week's Tur prices in Latur market appear to have decreased compared to last week.

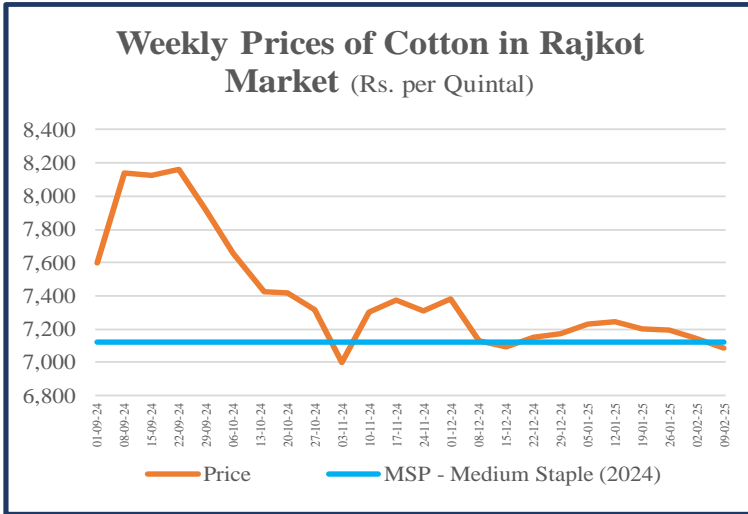

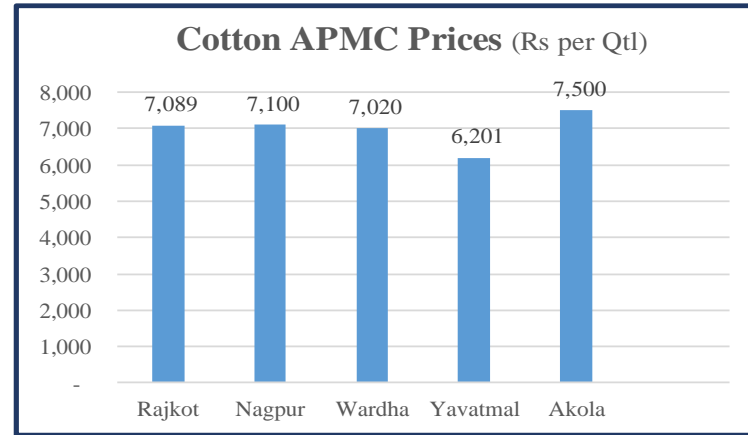
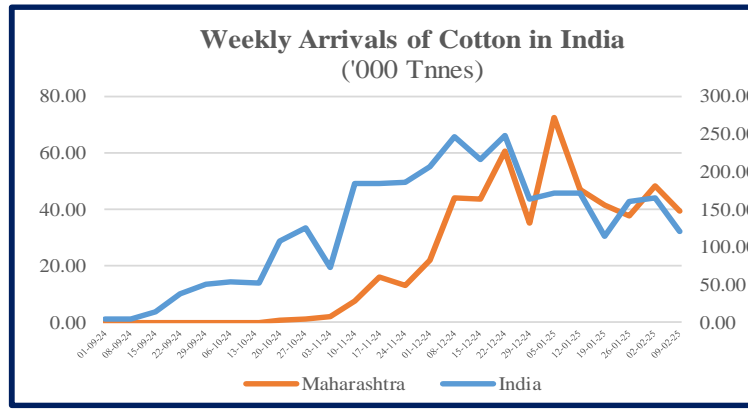


India's cotton production for the 2024-25 season is forecast to drop by 7.4% to 30.2 million bales due to reduced planted area and crop damage from excessive rainfall.

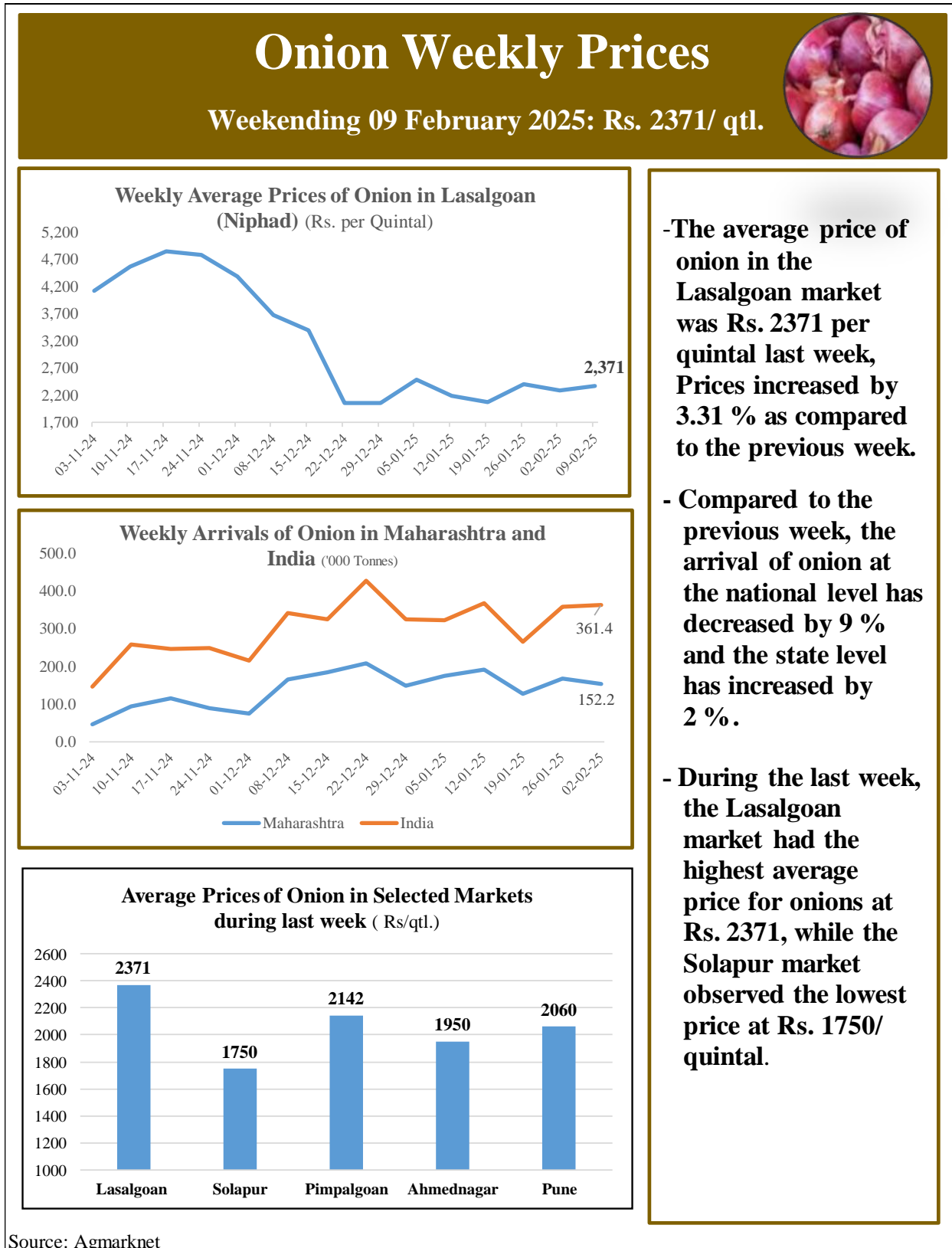
The USDA also revised its India production forecast down to 30.72 million bales, further tightening supply.

This decline in domestic production is expected to reduce exports and increase the need for imports, which are projected to rise to 2.5 million bales from 1.75 million bales in the previous year.

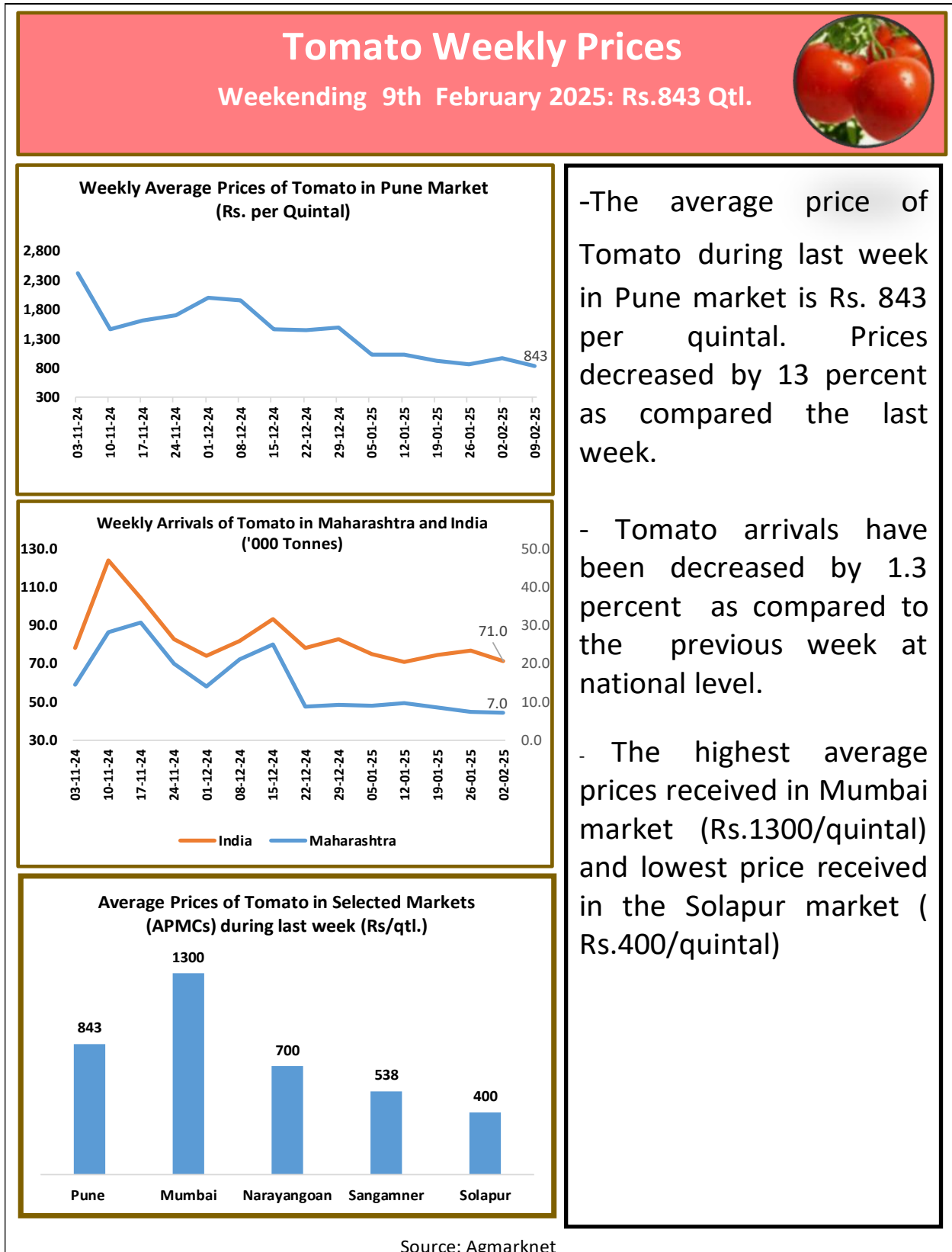
Cotton production is projected to increase in China, Brazil, and Argentina, more than offsetting reductions in the US and Spain




Weekly Prices of Turmeric in Hingoli Market

(Rs. per Quintal)





- Last week, in Hingoli Market the price was Rs. 12195 / per quintal. The price has decreased compared to last week.
- Compared to the previous week, the arrivals of turmeric at the national and state level has increased by 56.27% and 19.12 % respectively.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Turmeric at Rs.16000 /quintal in Sangli market, while the Hingoli market observed the lowest price at Rs. 12195 / qtl.
- The Global Turmeric market is anticipated to rise at a considerable rate during the forecast period, between 2024 to 2031.
- Maharashtra is ranked first in India in terms of area and production of turmeric in the year 2023–24.
- In Maharashtra Sangli, Hingoli, Nanded, Parbhani, Washim are the major turmeric growing districts
