


# Weekly Price of Maize By the end of 16 March 2025 : ₹ 2250 /Qtl.







Weekly Arrivals of Maize in India and





## Gram weekly Prices Week ending 16th March 2025: Rs. 5269/qtl




Gram Production is likely to be less than the previous year

This week's gram prices in Latur market appear to have increased compared to last week.




The MSP of Gram for Rabi season 2023-24 is Rs. 5440/Qtl





There has been 29.10 % decrease in the arrival of gram at national level compared to the previous week.

Current Prices are lower than MSP.




There has been 48.47 % decrease in the arrivals of Tur at national level compared to the previous week.



## Soybean Weekly Prices Weekending 16th March 2025: Rs.4032/qtl.











- The average prices of soybean in last week was Rs. 4032 per quintal in Latur market. Prices increased by 1.1 % as compare to its previous week.

## Weekly Price of Cotton By the end of 16 March 2025: ₹ 7,166/qtl.








The average price of Cotton during last week in Rajkot market is Rs. 7166/- per quintal.

- The highest average prices received in Akola market (Rs.7250/quintal) and lowest price received in the Yavatmal market (Rs.5800/quintal)







### **Onion Weekly Prices**






#### **Tomato Weekly Prices**

- The highest average prices received in Mumbai market (Rs.1200/quintal) and lowest price received in the Solapur market (Rs.420/quintal)






#### **Weekly Prices of Turmeric**

- Last week, in Hingoli Market the price was Rs. 10198 / per quintal. The price has decreased compared to last week.
- Compared to the previous week, the arrivals of turmeric at the national and state level have increased by 63.83 % and 71.87 % respectively.
- During the last week, the highest average price of Turmeric at Rs.15225/quintal in Sangli market, while the Higoli market observed the lowest price at Rs. 10198/qtl.
- The Global Turmeric market is anticipated to rise at a considerable rate during the forecast period, between 2024 to 2031.
- Maharashtra is ranked first in India in terms of area and production of turmeric in the year 2023–24.
- In Maharashtra Sangli, Hingoli, Nanded, Parbhani, Washim are the major turmeric growing districts
